Cook received his MFA from George Washington University and his B.A. in Photography from SUNY Plattsburgh. Cook's work has been published in the New York Times, Forbes, Frieze Magazine, NPR, Ebony Magazine, and Hyperallergic. Cook is a recipient of the 2024 Gordon Parks Fellowship. He is currently an Associate Professor at Howard University.
