Helen Downie is a London-based artist, best known for her idiosyncratic and expressive style of painting. Working under the moniker of Unskilled Worker, her work is intimate and evocative, mixing characters and nature with the ephemeral and fantastical. Her work has been chronicled extensively and has attracted a large audience worldwide. Her paintings have appeared in many publications, including Artnet, The New York Times, Vanity Fair, Vogue, Dazed, Harper's Bazaar and i-D. Her paintings are collected nationally and internationally and have been exhibited at galleries across the world including London, Hong Kong, New York, Seoul, Madrid, Tokyo and Shanghai. Downie is a strong voice for women, and through her exploration of gender enjoys testing new frontiers with her art. She is passionate about inclusion and through her work hopes to develop a narrative on the importance of diversity and freedom of expression, that speaks to everyone. Her work has been described as 'a melee of ethereality, innocence, inherent flow and instinct that all come together in a spectacular fashion.'
